It's all thanks to our wee pal **Emma Hales (5)** from Leicestershire who sent in the most colourful picture that Meg and I have ever clapped our eyes on.

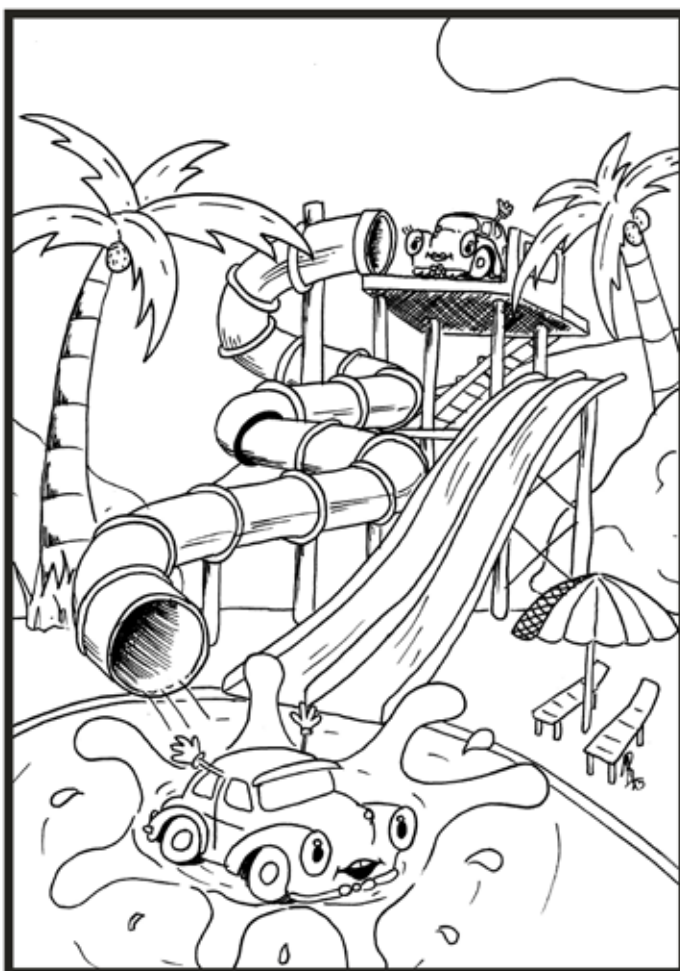
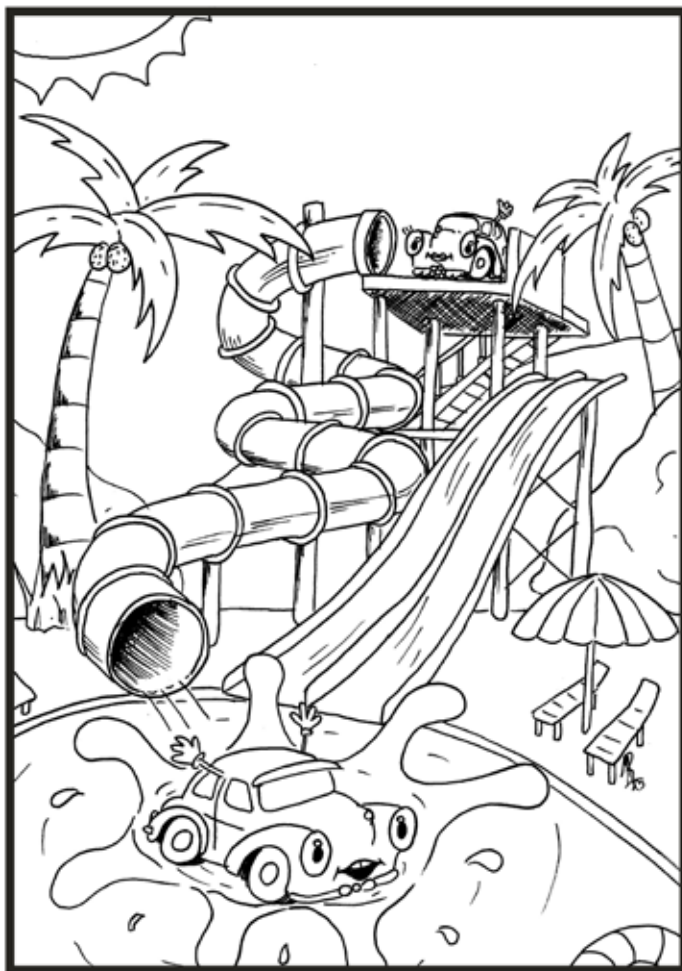
We were blown away by it and what a difference it makes to the garage walls, looks absolutely super dooper, lemon squeezy.

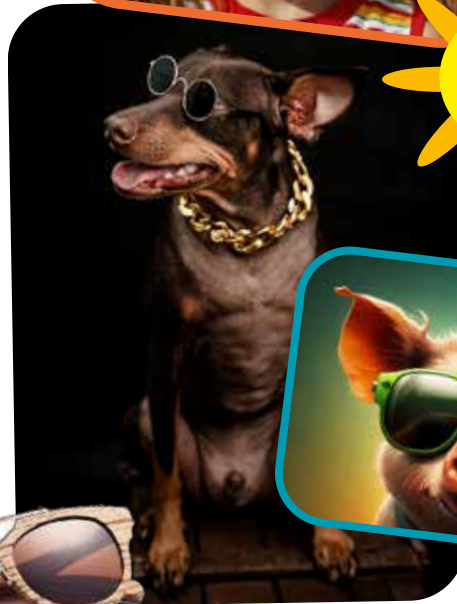
