HELLO FOLKS!

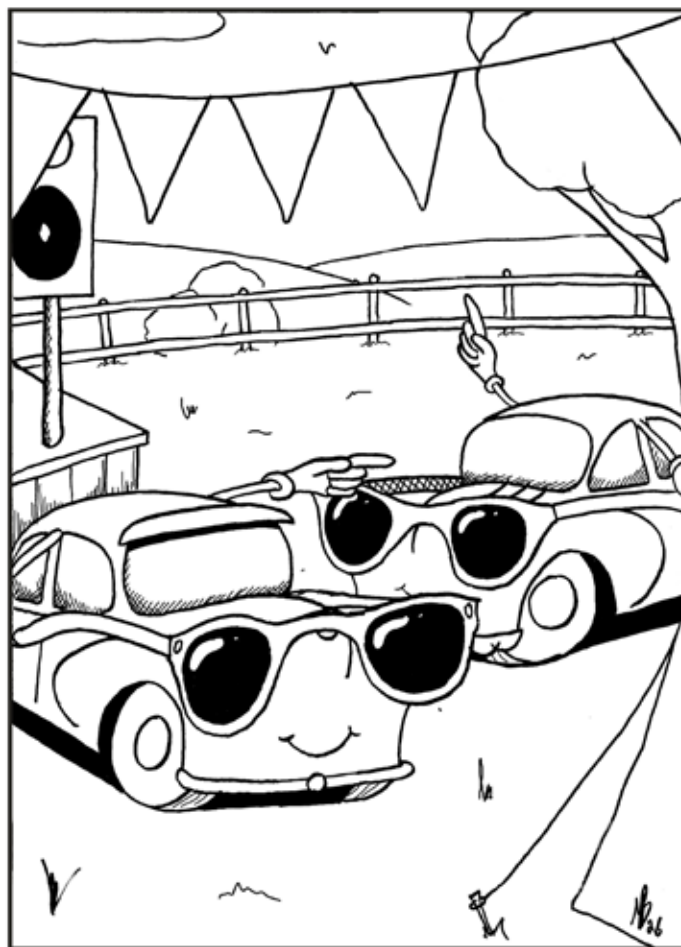
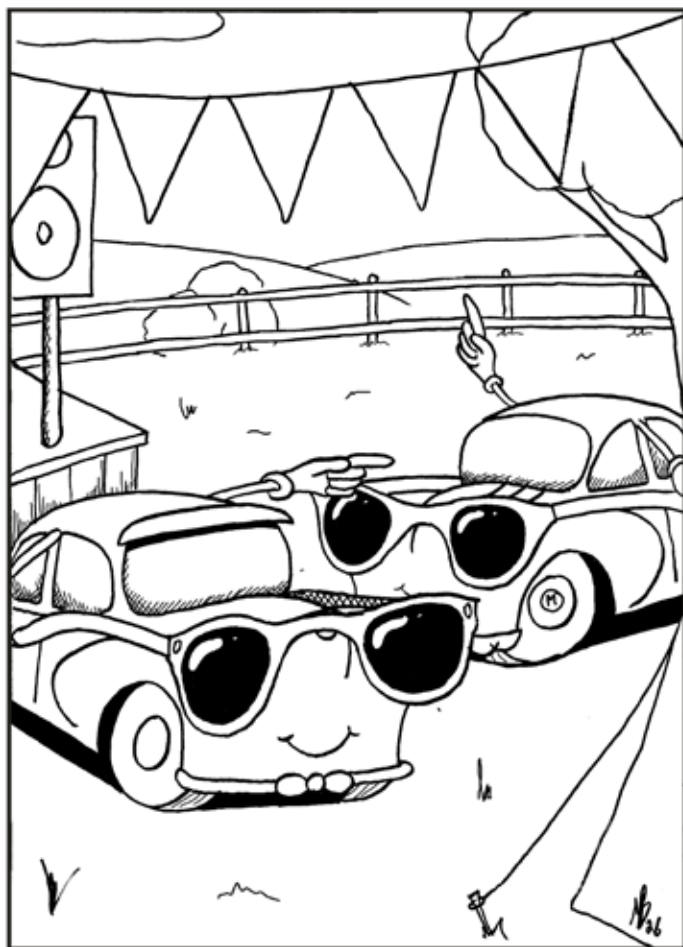
Whipee – the sun is still out and **Meg** and I are gearing up for a summer of festival fun.
